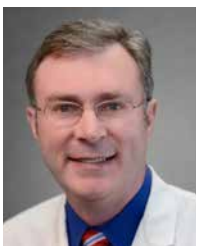


Cervicomedullary Syndrome (aka Craniocervical Syndrome)

Injuries to the upper neck frequently present with a wide variety of symptoms from visual and/or auditory disturbances, cranial nerve complaints and radiculomyelopathic symptoms.
